New Law Keeps Oil Filters and Absorbents Out of Landfills.

Beginning January 1, 2011 used automotive engine oil filters and oil absorbent materials are banned from Wisconsin landfills.

The new law was passed in 2009 to promote oil recycling and protect the environment. To help explain the ban, the DNR has developed a new [webpage](#) that includes information on what materials are covered under the ban and guidance on how to manage these materials.
