**COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAY P (SAWYER ROAD)
PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING SCHEDULED**

Waukesha, WIS. – Waukesha County’s Department of Public Works, along with the Village of Summit and design firm One Source Consulting, will host a public information meeting on the design for the proposed reconstruction of the CTH P (Sawyer Road) bridge over the Bark River from **5:00 to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 6, 2014 at Summit Village Hall.**

There will be a formal project presentation from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., including a question/answer session. The balance of the meeting time will be held in an open-house format. Representatives from Waukesha County, Village of Summit, One Source Consulting and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources will be available to discuss the project, answer questions and gather input and comments from the public. Preliminary plans and other exhibits will be on display for viewing. Written public comments will be accepted through May 23, 2014.

The project scope includes the following key aspects:

1. The existing twin cell box culvert would be reconstructed with a similar twin cell box culvert with additional length to accommodate on-street bicycles and sidewalks along both sides of CTH P (Sawyer Road).

2. The existing dam spillway that controls normal water levels for Lower Nemahbin, Upper Nemahbin, and Lower Nashotah lakes would be replaced in-kind with no changes to the height of the spillway.
3. The proposed action requires strip right-of-way acquisition and temporary easements along CTH P (Sawyer Road).
4. The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) property located at the bridge site will be impacted by the proposed action. The property is Fisheries Management lands associated with the Bark River. These lands were purchased by WDNR with US Fish and Wildlife Service – Sport Fish Restoration Program funds.

The meeting facility is wheelchair accessible. Hearing impaired persons needing assistance may call the Wisconsin Telecommunication Relay System (dial 711). To allow time for arranging assistance, please call no later than three working days prior to the meeting.
