Greetings from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation!

WIS 67 Update: The WIS 67 SB Bridge over I-94 was demolished and WIS 67 (SB) traffic has been switched to the east. Two lanes will remain open for both north and south traffic from the I-94 ramps to Oconomowoc Parkway. Traffic will be reduced to one-lane in both directions from Delafield Road (County DR) to I-94 and Oconomowoc Parkway to Armour Road. The project will remain in this configuration until late summer.

WIS 16 Project Update: As part of the ongoing WIS 16 project, crews will be removing the County KF Bridge deck in Waukesha County, requiring overnight, freeway closures of WIS 16 which passes underneath the structure.

Westbound and Eastbound traffic on WIS 16 will be routed along the exit and entrance ramps at County KF, bypassing the demolition area. Electronic signs will help direct motorists to the proper detour. Law enforcement will be assisting during stages of the operation. (Note: This project is separate from the WIS 67 project.)

- WIS 16 Westbound closure will be in effect Monday and Tuesday, June 22 and 23 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- WIS 16 Eastbound closure will be in effect Wednesday and Thursday, June 24 and 25 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
